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Attendance –

Recognising Good Attendance at Parkwood:

Since returning in September, we have monitored each student's attendance and you may have already received communication from the Academy if your child's attendance has dropped below our 97%. This will continue should your child's attendance continue to drop. We want to work with families to ensure all students attendance remains at a high level and we will be contacting you to offer support should it not. Attendance below 90% is classed as persistent absence, which means your child may achieve up to 2 grades below what they are capable of and also puts you at risk of prosecution from the local authority. It is important to us that we recognise and reward good attendance. This week we are promoting our rewards with students:

Weekly 100% raffle. From 1st November, if students get 100% in one week, their name will go in a raffle on the Friday. 10 Amazon vouchers available every week for 100% attenders **World Cup starts** – first England game is 21st November 22 at 1pm. Students need to have 100% attendance from 17th October – 21st November to be able to watch this opening game

Music Concert in School – Bailey333 will be performing in November here at Parkwood for Y7-9 students. Students need to have 97%+ attendance for half term 1 to be able to watch **Yorkshire Wildlife Park Visit** – Y8/9 who achieved 97%+ last academic year will receive an invitation letter for this trip

We also launched a family raffle. Invitations were sent by text message for families to sign up to a 100% raffle. We have 5, £40 Tesco vouchers up for grabs , and you have 4 chances of entering into the raffle. Each week your child has 100% attendance, you will receive a raffle ticket. Further rewards will be shared through the year. Each half term attendance reward activities and trips will run for students who achieve the 97% target the previous half term.
