CHANGE TO SCHOOL DAY

To support all members of our family we have made the decision to alter the school day by **10 minutes**. This means all students will be expected at E-ACT Parkwood Academy between the hours of **8:30am and 3:00pm**. This is a change to the end of the school day from 3:10pm to 3:00pm. Changes will come into effect from Wednesday 4th September **2024**.

This change still ensures that we meet the Department of Education's expectation of a 32.5-hour school week. All students will still receive five 1 hour lessons a day, as well as their enrichment time in the morning of 30 minutes. We have added 5 minutes to their break time (now 20 minutes instead of 15 minutes) and lunch time remains 30 minutes.

We believe that these **changes will be beneficial** to the school community and will have a **positive effect on your child's education**. This allows us to prioritise our extra-curricular and cultural capital offer (each day from 3:00pm until 4:00pm). It will also facilitate the transition home during our winter months and/or support those who pick up siblings.

The changes to the school day were overwhelmingly favoured by students in a recent survey and staff feedback was also positive.
